**2008/11/09 WSFHOA AGM**

Attending were 14 home-owners, supported by 68 Vote Proxies to make quorum. We discussed our 2008 budget of \$28k, about \$36k in outstanding fees at that time, major landscaping plans, increasing internet communication w/ a new website, another community-wide garage sale, area and community developments. **2009 ASSOCIATION DUES INVOICES**

**Your 2009 Home-Owner dues invoice is attached for your payment by July 31.**

Kindly address cheques to WSFHOA and mail to the letterhead address. Your cancelled cheque is your receipt. Association dues are calculated on a calendar year basis, Jan 1 through Dec 31, 2009 and include outstanding amounts for past years with interest at prime + 3% APR. We encourage you to review the Association’s Encumbrance and By-Law documents you will find attached to your home title for more information.

Note that past-Directors proposed a successful AGM motion to seek legal help to collect \$30k in currently outstanding dues, unpaid either intentionally or unintentionally, from a minority of Home-Owners in order to maintain our viability and prevent a general increase in dues during these tough economic times. All collection costs will be borne by the Home-Owner in default. (Sorry for the harsh note).

**VANDALISM (incl GRAFFITI), DOGS**

We repaired a fair bit of vandalism to Association and Home-Owner property this spring. If you see anyone damaging property using spray-paint, kicking fences down, kicking retaining blocks off, smashing bottles, littering or other dastardly acts and you do not feel safe in confronting the vandals please contact the appropriate agency:

### LANDSCAPING

With the assistance of a professional gardener, Kate of Passionate Gardener, we've made a big decision to go to different perennials this year that are better adapted to our smallish flower and feature beds. After a delay in getting the irrigation leaks repaired and fired up, all existing beds have been redone with new soil and mulch, the new perennials and annuals have been planted, and we are adding beauty and color to our community! We are also working on a feature bed at the SE corner of 73 St. & OBCR to brighten that entrance to our community.

### HARD ASSETS

The OBCR rail fence repairs from unprecedented vandalism have been essentially completed as you read this. The fancy entrance signs and a portion of our sound fence got a minor recoating due to some nasty graffiti. Winter-damaged sprinkler heads have been replaced and additional irrigation system isolation valves were installed to reduce future disruptions. \*If you see a sprinkler leak, call one of the Directors or our irrigation contractor at 403-467-9194 (Tim).

### WS Gate RETAINING WALL

Our developer, Landstar, provided a workman in 2008 to re-attach all available smaller rocks that have fallen off due to weather. They will provide a contact to quote on and handle more complex repairs and that will be passed on to affected Home-Owners.
